



Karin Eibschitz-Segal is corporate vice president and general manager of Intel Validation Engineering. In this role, she is responsible for delivering Intel's promise of highest quality products. Based in Israel, Karin is leading the global Intel engineering organization responsible for functional, electrical, and power/performance system validation of products. In addition, Eibschitz is the Co-General Manager of Intel Israel.

Since joining Intel in 2001, Karin has focused on the development of products, systems and infrastructure, tools, and methods. She has held multiple leadership positions in software, system engineering and validation organizations.
